

BLOMSTERGREN MED HÆKLEDE BLOMSTER

Flower branch

Spring is approaching - and until it starts to bloom with flowers, I will enjoy this branch. The flowers are crocheted, and if you want to see what I have done, click on the page via the link below - here you will get instructions and the procedure. It is a good idea for how to use up your yarn scraps.

You will need:

Yarn scraps - I have primarily chosen natural colors combined with green leaves. But it is a matter of taste - and also a question of what it should fit in with.

Crochet hook that matches the yarn (I used wool yarn and cotton yarn, suitable for crochet hook no. 3

Glue gun

Branch - find one in a suitable size in nature.

Here's how you do it:

I found patterns of different flowers on the website www.garnstudio.com and crocheted from these. I mixed the colors

a bit randomly but stuck to the natural colors. Leaves are crocheted in shades of green.

Crochet a lot of different flowers and attach the ends. Then I put the flowers on the branch with a small dab of glue/glue gun. No more than they just stick - so the glue becomes invisible between the flower and the branch.

The branch is placed in a narrow tall vase and it is placed on the floor. But you can choose smaller branches and put them in a vase on the table.
