

CROCHETED BUBBLE TOILETRY BAG

Are you looking for a practical and personal toiletry bag? With our free pattern, you can easily crochet your own unique toiletry bag. Whether you are a beginner or experienced crocheter, this pattern will guide you step by



step through the process. The result is a functional and stylish toiletry bag that perfectly suits your needs. Make your everyday life a little more creative with our crochet toilet bag.

Here's how you do it: Read the entire recipe through before you get started

M=mask

Sm=double crochet

Ch = chain stitch

Km=chain stitch

R=row

Stm=double crochet

This toiletry bag is crocheted in 3 parts and finally sewn together.

You need a crochet hook 3.5 and some fine yarn (or a needle that

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fits the yarn you want)

In this recipe we use: <https://hobbii.dk/friends-wheel> which is placed twice. About 600m have been used, so 1.5 keys

So you need:

- Crochet hook size 3-3.5
- Yarn in running length 600m
- A staple needle
- A normal needle to sew the parts together
- A zipper of 20-25 cm.
- A small pair of scissors
- Possibly a small piece of fabric for offal

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Front and back:

Start in R1 by casting on 41 ch and turn the work

R2 make a sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and continue to make a sc in each ch until the row is complete. Then make 3 ch to turn the work

R3 make 3 dc in the same st. The 3 ch count as one dc. Only pull the yarn through the first 2 loops and leave the last one on the needle. You must end up with 3 loops on the needle, pull the yarn through all 3 loops and make a ch.

Make 3 sc, make 2 dc in the same st. Repeat until the row is finished

R4: sc all sts until row is finished, finish with 1 ch to turn work

R5: make 2 sc. Make 2 dc in the same st.

Make 3 sc, make 2 dc in the same st, repeat until the row is finished. Make a ch to turn the work

R6: make sc in all sts, make 3 ch to turn work

R7-25: repeat R 3, 4, 5, 6 in order

R26: make a sc in each st. In the last st make a km, tie a knot and fasten all ends

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Now the front is done, to make the back repeat the process.

Bottom and sides:

The bottom and sides are crocheted in one long piece.

R1. Knit 11 ch

R2: low sc in each st. Turn the piece with 3 ch

R3: make 3 dc. The 3 ch count as one dc. Only pull the yarn through the first 2 loops and leave the last one on the needle. You must end up with 3 loops on the needle, pull the yarn through all 3 loops and make a ch.

Make 3 sc, make 2 dc in the same st. Repeat until the row is finished

R4: sc all sts until row is finished, finish with 1 ch to turn work

R5: make 2 sc. Make 2 dc in the same st.

Make 3 sc, make 2 dc in the same st, repeat until the row is finished. Make a ch to turn the work

R6: make sc in all sts, make 3 ch to turn work

R7- 87: repeat R 3, 4, 5, 6 in order

R88: low sc in all sts. Finish with km in the last st. and tie the knot. Staple all ends.

Now all the parts are made and must be sewn together. Place the long piece and the back side wrong sided. And sew in the outermost sts. All the way. Now put the piece on with the wrong

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side as well, and sew this on the other side.

Now the toilet bag is sewn together and can be turned right side out.

Here you can end the work and sew a zipper and possibly fabric in, or you can make a small border.

To make the edge, make 2 Rows of sl st on top of the toilet bag.

Really enjoy the work.
