METAL CAN CONTAINER

Metal can container.

A cute container that can be used for a bit of everything - here crochet hooks.

At the same time, it decorates the shelf.

The container is made from a metal can in which there have been peeled tomatoes - it has also been freshened up a bit with another "label" on the outside. See more below for how to do it.



You will need:

Metal can - for example as here from peeled tomatoes.

Yarn (with absorbency - not too synthetic). Cotton yarn or paper yarn are fine for the purpose.

Paverpol glue (can be bought in various hobby stores.

You do this:

Cut off the yarn that you want to use for the purpose. Make a small yarn key out of it. (I used 2 different colors - see the picture)

Dip it in paverpol glue (mixed with water - ratio 1/2 glue and water respectively).

Perhaps you can also use alm. white school glue mixed with water.....it must depend on a test - I haven't tried that yet.

Make sure the yarn is soaked - leave it in the mixture for a while.

The yarn is then wrapped around the container and the end is pressed firmly at the end. Let it dry.

Then you have a very nice container for various purposes. And even recycled your cans.
