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CUSHIONS WITH APPLIQUÉ

Cushions with appliqué

An idea and inspiration for refreshing old cushions or sewing new ones. These pillows have appliqué in the form of "wild stitching". A different idea for you who like something others don't have. And easy to make.



You will need:

Fabric for the pillow

Fabric residues

Vliesofix (sticks on both sides)

Sewing machine and sewing thread.

Pillow for filling

You do this:

Cut the fabric 2 cm. wider than the dimensions of the pillow - this gives you 1 cm. seam allowance all the way around the pillow. These pillows measure 50 cm. in width and length. I have cut the fabric 52x52 cm.

Iron vliesofix onto the fabric you want to use as decoration. Cut strips/or the decoration you now want. Remember to mirror if

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necessary when cutting the decoration. I have used strips in different colors. Then iron the fabric onto the cushion fabric. Vliesofix ensures that the motif is retained while you sew. Sew back and forth across the appliqué - a little tight. See the picture. You can also finish sewing other stitch types. It should look a bit random - it's wild sewing after all.

Then assemble the cushions by sewing the sides together. Leave an opening for the pillow. Put any zip in, if you want to be able to remove the cover. I've sewn these all the way without a zipper and when they need washing, the whole mole vitt smokes in the washing machine.
