PLACEMATS MADE OF FELT BALLS

Placemats made of felt balls. Can be expanded into a felt ball blanket Coasters are rare pretty, but this one is coming close to. A colorful one coasters made of felt balls. It decorates the table and fits almost any napkin ;o).



If you have the patience, you can you extend the project to to make a felt ball blanket.

You will need:

Felt balls, sewing needle, sewing thread.

The number of felt balls depends on the shape you choose to make the coaster in and how big it needs to be. You can buy felt balls in the Tiger stores or the Grene sisters. Or you can needle felt them yourself from wool ;o)

You do like that.

The balls are sewn together to form rings that can lie on top of each other. They are sewn together by hand and you poke the middle through the balls. After this, you must also sew the rings together so that they form the coaster.

You can also choose to make the coaster square, triangular or whatever strikes

your fancy.

Remember to staple the sewing thread in an invisible place - keep staples between the balls or leave a backing.
