CHRISTMAS TREES MADE OF BICYCLE TUBES

Christmas tree made of bicycle hose

Don't throw away your old bicycle hoses - or ask, if necessary, at your local bike dealer (he's usually happy to get rid of them). You can transform your old bicycle hoses into this nice Christmas tree. A little different.....but that's how I like it. You can see more about how to do it here. Good pleasure.



You will need:

Metal stick on foot - or: wooden skewers and a used metal can from corn or similar.

2-3 old bicycle hoses

Glitter Spray

Pliers or other "mandrel" to make a hole in the hose with.

You do this:

If you use a barbecue skewer (can be wooden) or other stick, then it must be put in a can made from corn, which has a lump of clay at the bottom. If you use a metal stick on the foot, this is not necessary.

Cut 4-5 pieces of hose measuring approx. 15 cm in length.

Cut a hole with hole punches in the middle of the bicycle hose pieces. The hole must not be too large and must be smaller than the width of the stick. The hole can give, as the material is rubber. Pull the hoses down over the stick. Distribute the pieces so that they form a wreath.

Cut 4-5 pieces of hose of approx. 13-13.5 cm. Cut a hole in the middle with hole punches and place the pieces on the stick evenly spaced around.

This is done towards the top. But the length of the pieces must constantly get smaller and smaller in length towards the top, so that the wood tapers.

When the tree is finished, spray it with glitter spray and you can put a pearl, star or similar. on with a glue gun or other glue. And voila, you have the finest Christmas tree - a little different, but then you have something others don't have!
