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INSPIRATION FOR A CROCHETED BEDSPREAD

Crocheted bedspread

If you are up for a slightly larger (time-wise) but also reasonably simple project, then here is an opportunity. You get free inspiration for how I made this bedspread. Colors and pattern variations can be mixed



as you see fit. So pick up the crochet hook and let your imagination run free when it comes to patterns and structures...

You will need:

Per stripe, approx. 4 skeins of cotton yarn 8/4 are used and are crocheted with crochet hook no. 3.5.

Cast on 50 chain stitches and crochet long courses until the courses have the desired length that suits you and the bed it will cover.

The patterns on the courses are different - it can be, for example, 2 double crochets, 2 chain stitches in a row - then it will be checkered/with holes (if you wish, it can also be striped - then holes must be placed over holes and double crochets over double crochets.

Other rows are crocheted with alternating 2 holes and 4 treble crochets

Others are crocheted with a whole row of treble crochets and a

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row of holes over 2 chain stitches.

It is only your imagination that sets the limits.

If you want to try out different patterns, you can make small crochet samples first.

The bed blanket is crocheted in strips and then the strips are crocheted together with double crochets and a contrasting color - you just have to make sure you count the rows in relation to how long you want the blanket to be, so that each strip has the same number of rows. If they are not the same length, it may draw crookedly.

Another advantage is that there is no crocheted border around the carpet. Right now I have a 3/4 bed, but if it is replaced with a slightly larger bed, I can expand the blanket by crocheting several rows.
