HØNSEGÅRDEN - CROCHETED CHICKENS

The chicken coop (crocheted chickens)

I have found a website with the recipe for these chickens there are very few changes compared to the original recipe. If you want to see more, take a look below.



You must use: Leftovers (about half skeins) of cotton yarn in different colours. Crochet hook suitable for the yarn (I used needle no. 3), scraps of felt for the beak, scraps of yarn for the "comb", glue gun. Pillow filling for the bodies.

The hen (turquoise) on the far left is according to the original recipe, which you will find on the website above. I've played with the other two a bit - I've made the yellow one shorter and the one in the middle thinner and taller.

But you can use the instructions on the website above and adapt it to whatever shape you want.

Instead of crocheting the beaks, I used scraps of felt that were glued on with a glue gun.

Instead of crocheting a comb, I have used leftover yarn, which is inserted as a "fountain" at the top of the hen.
