CUTE LITTLE SNOWMEN

Cute little snowmen.

Hey out there - check us out!! Small snowmen that you can make yourself. Here you get the idea and the procedure for free. A very merry Christmas. These snowmen were created when I found a branch which had probably fallen off after a huge storm.....It had to be able to be used for something. Here is the result.



Children and adults together can easily make these cute snowmen. See more below.

For the little snowmen you will need:

Yarn scraps, half-thick branch from a tree, knitting needles, felt for hands, bonzai thread for arms, glue gun.

If you don't want to knit the hat and scarf yourself, you can use ready-made tube knitting.

Small snowmen - Here's how you do it:

Saw the branch into pieces - thicknesses of approx. 4-5 cm. File the bottom flat - and also flat where the head and body are to be joined together.

Glue the body parts (head and stomach) together with a glue gun. Glue a piece of bonzai wire to the back - where the head and body meet.

Knit hats and scarves for the snowmen. The number of stitches must correspond to the circumference of the head. The scarf can vary in stitch count and length, depending on how wide you think it should be. The appearance of the hats can be varied a lot - I have tried to make slightly different looks and you have to let yourself be inspired ;o)

The hats are decorated with tassels.

The hands are made from 2 round pieces of felt which are glued on at the end of the arms.

Leave the arms slightly curved - this gives life to the snowman.

Eyes, nose and mouth are drawn on with marker.

Tie a scarf and put on the hat. (They are not glued and can be removed)
