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FUR TASSEL FOR HAT - DIY

Pelskvast DIY

Fur tassels on hats are pretty expensive to buy but oh how cute I think they are. That is why I have tried to create a fur tassel myself, for which I am giving you the idea and the recipe. I also briefly describe how I knitted the hat.

You will need:

1 skein of yarn (needles 6.5 -7) - I have used a soft thick wool yarn from Drops here.

Small circular needle or double pointed needles

Piece of fur (synthetic or real) measuring 12×12 cm

Strong sewing thread

You do this:

Fur Tassel: Draw up on the back so that you get a round piece of fur with a diameter of approx. 11-15 cm (depending on how big you think it should be. Sew with strong sewing thread with a rib stitch around the edge - all the way around. Pull the fur together and stuff a bit of batting/pillow filling into the tassel. Pin thoroughly and leave the sewing thread behind, then you can use it to sew the tassel on the hat.

You can also mount a large push button at the bottom of the tassel - and mount the opposite part of the push button on the hat - then the tassel can be removed from the hat when it is washed....



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Hat:

Cast on 48 stitches on needle size 6.5-7 and knit rib (knit 2, purl 2) so that you almost have the desired length of the hat. Then decrease as follows:

- 1. Knit 2 together, purl 2 alle the round.
- 2. Knit 1 round without decreases
- 3. Knit 1, purl 2 together all the round
- 4. Knit one round without decreases
- 5. Break the yarn (not too short a string) and pull the end through the remaining stitches. Pin the ends and sew on the tassel (possibly with a press stud).
