CROCHETED CHICKEN

Crocheted chicken

Chicken rouille is crocheted here - and are you - curious to know what it is like

made? So look below and find

the recipe.

It is easy to make and only requires one leftover yarn - so a good alternative to get

used the leftover yarn.

You will need:



A leftover yarn (here red and green), crochet hook no. 3, 2 beads for eyes, pillow stuffing/wadding, a little leftover felt or similar. to the "comb"

You do this:

Cast on 30-40 chain stitches (ch) on crochet hook no. 3 and join them into a circle with a slip stitch (sl st) in the first ch.

Then single crochet straight up - round and round until you think it's a suitable length. It is best if the tube is longer than the width - maybe about 1/3 longer than it is wide... (so it doesn't become square).

When the tube is crocheted, the yarn is broken and the chicken is sewn together "across" at one end and "along" at the other end. Remember to fill it with pillow stuffing/wadding or similar. before it is completely closed.

The beak: Cast on 3 ch - crochet 2 sc in this row (the first ch is used to turn). In the next round crochet 3 sc, then on the next row 4 ch, next row 5 ch, next row 4 ch, next row 3 ch, finish with a row with 2 ch. This means that you remove 1 stitch on each row until you have 5 ch. Then you take in 1 st on each row until there are 2 sc. back. Staple ends.

Sew on eyes and beak. Sew the comb on.

The comb could also be small pieces of yarn that bristled up a bit - it doesn't have to be felt..... Then it would be an advantage to make the comb before sewing together - then you could have the cords attached to the back.
