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## CROCHETED SHAWL WITH TONGUES / CLAMS

Crochet shawl with tongues.  
A fun relief pattern - to be set  
good time - and patience is needed.  
But there are many who have it  
lots of. Below you will find  
procedure and guidance.

It's all worth it - the finished thing  
result will be incredibly beautiful and  
different.

### **You will need:**

#### **Crochet hook no. 3-3.5**

For this shawl I used 3.5 keys  
"Hot Socks - Spektra" yarn. Each  
yarn wrench has a running length of 420  
meter and contains 100 grams per key. But the yarn consumption also depends  
on how big a shawl you want... But as you can sense, more yarn is used than for  
ordinary shawls.

### **You do this:**

I found the procedure in a Hendes Verden supplement - and I just link to a girl  
who is working on the shawl. Here you can see a picture, and combined with  
the recipe/technique, you'll get started.....

I have chosen not to make the edge on the outside, as the pattern says - but simply crocheted

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2 rows of double crochets on top of the shawl to finish.....I like things to be simple. But it is taste and pleasure.
