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CROCHETED SHAWL WITH TONGUES / CLAMS

Crochet shawl with tongues.

A fun relief pattern - to be set good time - and patience is needed.

But there are many who have it lots of. Below you will find procedure and guidance.

It's all worth it - the finished thing result will be incredibly beautiful and different.

You will need:

Crochet hook no. 3-3.5

For this shawl I used 3.5 keys
"Hot Socks - Spektra" yarn. Each
yarn wrench has a running length of 420

meter and contains 100 grams per key. But the yarn consumption also depends on how big a shawl you want... But as you can sense, more yarn is used than for ordinary shawls.

You do this:

I have chosen not to make the edge on the outside, as the pattern says - but simply crocheted

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2 rows of double crochets on top of the shawl to finish......I like things to be simple. But it is taste and pleasure.
