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SOCKS WITH "EEL" IN THE SHAFT - INSPIRATION

Inspiration for knitted socks with "eel" in the shaft.

If you need a little variety in your sock repertoire, here is a good offer. The socks fit well and have a fun shaft with "eel"/waves

You can see more below, where I have described how I made the shafts. Have fun



You will need:

For a pair of socks, you need 2 skeins of stocking yarn - and knitting needles. I have knitted these socks on needle 3.

Your knitted socks - you can do this:

Recipes for socks can be found in many places on the internet - you can, for example, find recipes for www.garnstudio.com.

These socks are knitted with an eel in the shaft and a wedge heel.

To achieve the "eel" effect, do the following:

The number of stitches must be divisible by 6. In this case (women's model size 39) I have used 60 stitches divided by 15 stitches on each needle.

First knit approx. 3 cm rib = knit 1, purl 1.

The following 12 rounds must then be repeated until the shaft has the desired length:

- 3 rounds: knit
- 3 rounds: knit 3, purl 3
- 3 rounds: purl
- 3 rounds: purl 3, knit 3.

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Then knit the heel and foot as usual. This idea is passed down and only deals with the shaft of your socks.
